The Yukon Aboriginal Women’s Council works in partnership with the Native Women’s Association of Canada to deliver employment and training services for Yukon Aboriginal women and gender diverse individuals to provide them with the opportunity to gain meaningful and lasting employment.

Eligible Clientele are:

- Residents of Yukon
- Indigenous Women and gender diverse people (First Nation, Inuit and Métis)
- Fifteen (15) years of age or older
- Unemployed, under-employed, or able to demonstrate immediate risk of being unemployed
- Eligible for a maximum of 2 years of funding
